GOVERNMENTAL SYSTEM

The US is a representative democratic constitutional republic regulated by a series of checks and balances based on its Constitution. This includes three branches of federal government: Executive, Legislative and Judicial. The president serves four-year terms and can veto legislative bills (subject to approval by Congress), is commander-in-chief of the military (however only the legislative branch can declare war) and appoints the Cabinet (subject to approval by Congress). The Legislative branch is a bicameral congress of the Senate and House of Representatives, this branch can do pretty much anything with a 2/3 vote that the Judicial branch doesn't find unconstitutional.
